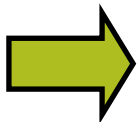
Access Steps:

Go to: www.lislelibrary.org/LLDdatabases from within the library.

Select “Ancestry Library Edition.”

GETTING STARTED:



Click on the green “Begin Seaching” button on the

Begin Searching



Start by entering everything you know about your ancestor; “First & Middle Name (s),” “Last Name,” “Place your ancestor might have lived,” and “Birth Year.” You can further refine your search by clicking on “Show more options” and entering any additional information in the optional fields.



You can also narrow your results by choosing “Explore by collection” on the right side of the page for “Census & Voters Lists,” “Birth, Marriage & Death,” “Immigration & Travel,” and “Military.”
