AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A BUDGET AND APPROPRIATION OF SUCH SUMS OF MONEY AS MAY BE DEEMED NECESSARY TO DEFRAY ALL NECESSARY EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF THE LISLE LIBRARY DISTRICT, LISLE, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2013, AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2014, AND SPECIFYING THE OBJECTS AND PURPOSES FOR WHICH SUCH APPROPRIATIONS ARE MADE AND THE AMOUNT APPROPRIATED FOR EACH OBJECT OR PURPOSE.

Section 2: As part of the Annual Budget, it is stated:

- (a) That the cash on hand at the beginning of the fiscal year is \$ 7,349,865.44
- (b) That the estimated cash expected to be received during the fiscal year from all sources is \$4,995,393.11
- (c) That the estimated expenditures for the fiscal year are \$ 5,398,151.16
- (d) That the estimated cash expected to be on hand at the end of the fiscal year is \$ 6,947,107.39.
- (e) That the estimated amount of taxes to be received by the Lisle Library District during the fiscal year is \$ 4,507,693.11.
- (f) That the estimated amount of income to be received from sources other than library taxes for the fiscal year is \$ 487,700.00
- Section 3: That the funds in the total amount of \$ 6,099,820.81 or so much thereof as may be authorized by law, be and the same are hereby appropriated for the

corporate purposes of the Lisle Library District, as hereinafter specified, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013 and ending June 30, 2014.

Section 4: The receipts and revenue of the said Lisle Library District derived from sources other than taxation and specifically appropriated and all unexpended balances from the preceding fiscal year not required for the purpose for which they were appropriated and levied shall be transferred to and become part of the Special Reserve Fund for the purchase of Sites and Buildings, the Construction, Repair, Remodeling, Improving and Equipping of the Same.

Section 5: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval and publication as required by law.
