APPLY TODAY FOR *YOUR* LIBRARY CARD:

All Lisle Library District (LLD) residents are eligible for a Library card, regardless of age. The Library District includes most of the Village of Lisle, including unincorporated subdivisions such as Four Lakes, Woodridge Estates, and The Meadows. Portions of unincorporated Naperville are also included (Steeple Run).

HOW TO APPLY & COMPLETE REGISTRATION:

- Visit lislelibrary.org and click on **My Account** at the top right-hand corner.
- Next, click on "pre-register now" and fill in the required information, including your email address.
- We will email your new LLD barcode/username within 48 hours.
- The email you receive will have more details about your temporary account (expires within 60 days, unless otherwise noted).
- After receiving the email, visit the LLD Circulation Services Desk just inside the Front Street entrance, to complete your registration for a full-term card (two years). Please bring a photo ID and proof of your Lisle District address.
- We accept the following documents as proof of valid address: Illinois Driver's License, state ID, current utility bill or recent USPS mail with your name and current address.
