A MESSAGE FROM THE LIBRARY DIRECTOR



The LLD has recently undergone a facility assessment to evaluate the current condition of the building and campus.
Results of the report can be found within

the July LLD Board packet via *lislelibrary.org*. The purpose of this examination was to inform the LLD of projected maintenance costs for current mechanical, electrical, environmental, and structural systems.

This report does not forecast any costs for architectural change or innovation regarding space. However, this report does provide a maintenance cost baseline for the next 5-10+ years. It's important for the LLD to understand the investment in maintaining systems as they are configured and to plan ahead for advances and efficiencies.

The assessment report has recommended a few immediate upgrade projects. As for larger capital projects and improvements, please stay tuned! It's important that the LLD measure all options, make cost-effective decisions, and ensure that choices made are in the best interests of all of our patrons.
