

A MESSAGE FROM THE LIBRARY DIRECTOR

While continuing to assess the LLD's options regarding larger capital improvements, the LLD has advanced a few immediate upgrades as recommended by our recent facility assessment report. Those advancements include replacing facility air handlers, sidewalk repairs, exchanging fluorescent bulbs for LED bulbs, and repairing a storm water pipe on Front Street.

Outside of the assessment report recommendations, the LLD has also advanced key Strategic Plan objectives that focus on patron convenience and Universal Design principles. We plan to position the outside book-drops to accommodate both SUVs and sedans. Soon, you will see two book-drops at hospitable heights for your vehicle.

We also just completed a project that creates a more welcoming, functional, and inclusive environment for our patrons. The LLD installed multi-level countertops/sinks in our east-end restrooms. Children, those who use a wheelchair, or patrons who simply appreciate a lower option, may now utilize our facilities with more range.

The LLD remains committed to ensuring that our facility is well maintained while pursuing options for larger improvements. Public libraries have evolved into community collaboration spaces, hubs for knowledge and instruction, and centers for STEAM exploration and inspiration. We are also your go-to for a great book or movie recommendation. Come visit us today!


