



Lisle Library District Cardholders:

OCLC FirstSearch is an online catalog of books and other materials located in libraries across the world (including LLD) with 13 different databases that can connect you to information in a wide range of subjects.

Access Steps:

From Your Computer:

Go to: <u>www.lislelibrary.org/LLDdatabases</u> Select "OCLC First Search." Enter your library card number and PIN. Click "Login."

Getting Started:



Click on the "Databases" or "Databases by Topic" tab to choose to search in up to 3 of the 13 different databases. Click on the "WorldCat" link for information on books, DVDs, and CDs. Search by Keyword, Author, Title, or ISBN. Limit the results to books, visual materials, or sound, using the tabs above the results.

Click on a search result and then click on "Libraries worldwide that own the item." Scroll past the list of libraries for more information, such as a description and the year published.



If you find an item that is not owned by the Lisle Library and you would like to request it from another library, make a note of the Title, Author, and Accession Number from the top of the search result and contact the Library at adultservices@lislelibrary.org or (630) 971-1675.
