With **Ancestry Library Edition** you can unlock the story of you, with sources from censuses, vital records, immigration records, family histories, military records, court and legal documents, directories, photos, maps, and much more.

Access Steps:

Access is only available from within the library.

Go to: www.lislelibrary.org/LLDdatabases from within the library.

Select “Ancestry Library Edition.”

GETTING STARTED:



To search entire collection, on the Home page click on **Begin Searching**



Start by entering everything you know about your ancestor; “First & Middle Names(s),” “Last Name,” “Place your ancestor might have lived,” and “Birth Year.” You can further refine your search by clicking on “Show more options” and entering any known information in the optional fields.



You can also narrow your results by searching the most widely used collections. Click on the “Search” drop-down menu and select; “Census & Voters Lists,” “Birth, Marriage & Death,” “Military,” or “Immigration & Travel.”

Or

Select “Card Catalog” and choose from over 10,000 record collections. In the Card Catalog you can do a “Title” or “Keyword(s)” search or you can “Filter by Collection.”
