Access **The New York Times** website (News Only) on any device during your library visit without having to enter library card information.

ACCESS STEPS:

1. Go to lislelibrary.org/databases
2. Select **NEW YORK TIMES (Inside the Library Only)** from the list
3. Register for a free NYT Account, or sign-in to an existing account.

GETTING STARTED:

1. On the homepage, scroll to access articles from that day as you would access a paper copy.
 - a. Or, choose from the list of sections along the top of the screen: **U.S., WORLD, BUSINESS, ARTS, LIFESTYLE, OPINION, VIDEO, AUDIO**. In-Library access does *not* include NYTGames or The Wirecutter.
 - b. You can also browse the U.S. copy of the paper, the international, Canadian, Spanish, and Chinese editions.
2. Find the magnifying glass icon at the top of the page to search for articles, keywords, or journalist bylines.
3. This access also includes all of the currently available games and their archives once you have registered your account.

*Your LLD PIN is typically the last 4 digits of your phone number. If this doesn't work, please visit or contact the library to have it reset.
