With **Ancestry Library Edition** you can unlock the story of you, with sources from censuses, vital records, immigration records, family histories, military records, court and legal documents, directories, photos, maps, and much more.

ANCESTRY ACCESS IS ONLY AVAILABLE FROM WITHIN THE LIBRARY.

ACCESS STEPS:

1. Using one of the library's public computers, or by accessing the library's public wifi network on your device, go to lislelibrary.org/databases and select **Ancestry Library Edition** from the list.
2. Enter your library barcode number and PIN*
3. Click **Begin Searching**

TIPS & TRICKS FOR SEARCHING:

1. Start by entering everything you know about your ancestor
 - a. "First & Middle Name(s)," "Last Name,"
 - b. "Place your ancestor might have lived,"
 - c. "Birth Year."
 - d. You can further refine your search by clicking on **SHOW MORE OPTIONS** and entering any additional information in the optional fields.
2. You can also narrow your results by choosing **EXPLORE BY COLLECTION** on the right side of the page for
 - a. "Census & Voters Lists,"
 - b. "Birth, Marriage & Death,"
 - c. "Immigration & Travel,"
 - d. and "Military."
3. Print or email any documents to yourself by clicking the green **SEND DOCUMENT** button.

*Your LLD PIN is typically the last 4 digits of your phone number. If this doesn't work, please visit or contact the library to have it reset.
