ACCESS STEPS:

1. Go to lislelibrary.org/databases
2. Select **LINKEDIN LEARNING** from the list
3. Enter your library card number and PIN*
4. Click **GET STARTED**.

GETTING STARTED:

1. On the left sidebar, click **CONTENT**
 - a. Choose from **Business**, **Technology**, or **Creative** for lists of topics.
 - b. Click on a topic for a list of courses, or enter a skill / subject / software into the search box.
2. Click to open a course
 - a. On the **Overview** tab underneath the video, view the *Learning Objectives and Skills Covered*.
 - b. View the **Contents** on the left side of the video and play selected videos or watch straight through.
 - c. Open the **Notebook** tab under the video to type notes with a timestamp that you can click on later to return to the point in the video when the note was made.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The **MY LIBRARY** tab on the top of the homepage lists courses that are *In-Progress*, *Saved*, *My Collections*, and *Learning History*, and you can return to these courses by clicking on them.
- Click on the **ME** tab for *Settings* and *Language*— changing the language includes the site, slides, and transcript.
